

ORDINANCE 2021 - 12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FY21 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO CREATE A BUILDING INSPECTOR POSITION AND FUND IT WITH CURRENT YEAR BUDGET SAVINGS

WHEREAS: The City Council adopts an annual operating budget for all municipal funds to provide for the efficient and transparent use of public resources; and

WHEREAS: The cost of personnel salaries and benefits is the largest expense category within the municipal budget; therefore, the City controls the creation of new employee positions through the annual budget process; and

WHEREAS: The City Council desires to improve the responsiveness and timeliness of building plan reviews and building inspections to promote additional development and investment within the community; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS

SECTION 1. The City Council amends the FY21 General Fund Budget to authorize the creation of a new Building Inspector position within the Community Development Department.

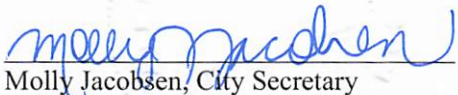
SECTION 2. The creation of the new Building Inspector position must be funded from current year savings within the FY21 Budget and may not increase the total expenditure amount authorized under the current FY21 Budget.

SECTION 3. In any section, sub-section, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

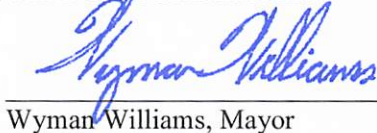

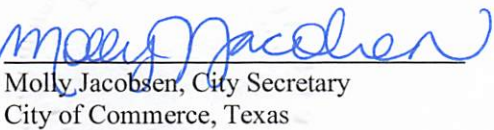
