

ORDINANCE 2022 - 08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 ("FY 2022") PUBLIC UTILITY FUND BUDGET TO ADD A NEWLY ESTABLISHED PUBLIC UTILITIES MANAGEMENT ASSISTANT POSITION AND FUND IT WITH CURRENT YEAR BUDGET SAVINGS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS: The City Council adopts an annual operating budget for all municipal funds to provide for the efficient and transparent use of public resources; and

WHEREAS: The cost of personnel salaries and benefits is the largest expense category within the municipal budget; therefore, the City controls the creation of new employee positions through the annual budget process; and

WHEREAS: The City Council desires to improve existing city infrastructure and safely promote additional development and investment within the community; and

WHEREAS, the City has the opportunity to create a new position within our Public Utilities Department that relieves some of the administrative workload on the City Manager and Public Utilities Director to allow their focus on other issues;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS

SECTION 1: The City Council amends the FY22 Public Utilities Fund Budget to authorize the creation of a new Management Assistant position within the Public Utilities Department.

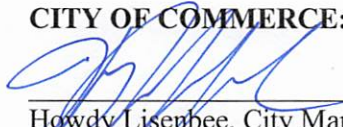
SECTION 2: The creation of the new Management Assistant position must be funded from current year savings within the FY22 Budget and may not increase the total expenditure amount authorized under the current FY22 Budget.

SECTION 3. In any section, sub-section, word, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not affect the validity of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance was open to the public as required by Texas law, and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given.

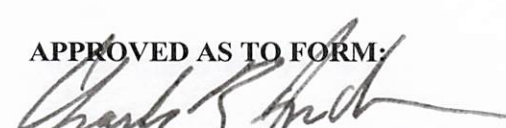

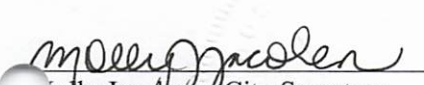
