

ORDINANCE NO. 2022 - 15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE 2022 - 2023 FISCAL YEAR ("FY 2023") BUDGET COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023 FOR THE CITY OF COMMERCE; PROVIDING THAT EXPENDITURES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FY 2023 BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, an annual, operating budget for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023 ("Fiscal Year 2023") has been duly created by City Manager Howdy Lisenbee and Finance Director Jamie Campbell of the City of Commerce with the input of the City Council and City Staff and in accordance with sections 102.002 and 102.003 of Texas Local Government Code, and

WHEREAS, the FY 2023 Proposed Budget reflects the revenues and expenditures necessary for conducting the affairs of the City of Commerce and provides a complete financial plan for the Fiscal Year 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director of the City of Commerce filed the proposed budget on July 15, 2022 in the Office of the City Secretary and made the proposed budget available for public inspection by taxpayers in accordance with section 102.005(b) of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of said budget will require raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous Fiscal Year 2022, and the City Council will, by separate vote, ratify the property tax increase reflected in the FY 2023 budget; and

WHEREAS, all notices and public hearings required by law have been duly completed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce is of the opinion that the budget hereinafter set forth is proper and should be approved and adopted; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

The City of Commerce operating budget for the fiscal year October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023, a true copy of which is made permanently available on record in the City Secretary's office, be and is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 1. The expenditures during the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023, shall be made in accordance with the budget approved

by this ordinance unless otherwise authorized by a duly enacted ordinance amending the budget by the City Council of Commerce, Texas.

SECTION 2. Should any section, subsection, word, sentence, subdivision or phrase of this ordinance be adjudged or declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; the same shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from October 1, 2022 after one reading, consistent with Article III, Section 26, part 4(a) of the Charter for the City of Commerce.

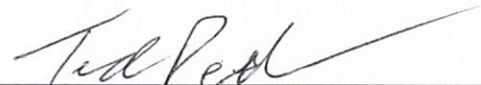

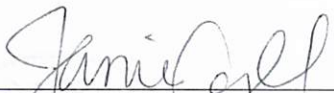

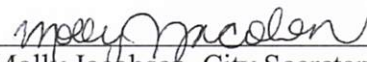
