

RESOLUTION NO. 11-08

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TEXAS PROPERTY TAX CODE, SECTION 33.11; GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO SAID RESOLUTION. GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL OTHER INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNATURE TO ANY AND ALL OTHER INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall on the 15th day of March 2011, at 6:00 p.m.; a majority of Council Members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce wishes to defray its costs of collection, as authorized by Texas Property Tax Code §§ 33.11, that it incurs under a contract for collection of delinquent property taxes between said City and a private law firm entered into pursuant to Texas Property Tax Code § 6.30;

WHEREAS, under said Section 33.11, the City Council of the City of Commerce is empowered to authorize the addition of a collection penalty in an amount that does not exceed the amount of the compensation specified in the contract with the private law firm.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas that:

Section 1: The recitals set forth in this Resolution are true and correct.

Section 2: An additional penalty on delinquent personal property taxes for tax years 2010 and subsequent years is hereby authorized and imposed, as provided by Section 33.11, Texas Property Tax Code, in the amount of 20% of the delinquent tax, penalty and interest if the tax becomes delinquent on or after February 1 of a year and remains delinquent on the 60th day thereafter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the City of Commerce, Texas, be authorized and he is hereby authorized to execute said resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Secretary be authorized and she is hereby authorized to authenticate the signature of the Mayor to said resolution.

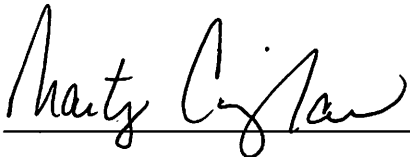
