

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-18**

**A RESOLUTION AND ORDER CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A CITY OFFICERS' ELECTION AND CHARTER AMENDMENT ELECTION. GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO SAID RESOLUTION. GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL OTHER INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNATURE TO ANY AND ALL OTHER INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION.**

There came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 14th day May, 2011 for the purpose of electing the hereinafter named officials and charter amendments, and it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made, that there were cast at said election 397 valid and legal votes; that each of the candidates in said election received the following votes for the full term:

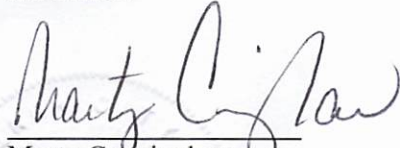
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS;**

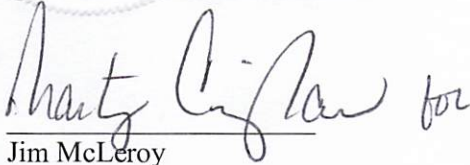

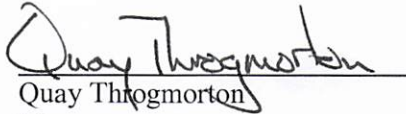

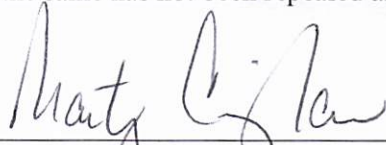
