A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall, on the 19th day July 2011 at 6:00 p.m., majority of Council Members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted:

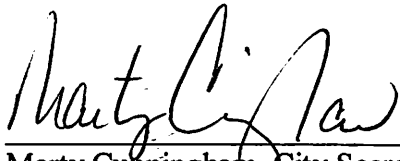
