

RESOLUTION NO. 11-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE APPROVING A MULTI-YEAR AGREEMENT FOR TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE OF A SEGMENT OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall, on the 16th day of August 2011, at 6:00 p.m., a majority of council members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Run for the Red will be held downtown September 10, 2011; and

WHEREAS, City Staff requests approval of the temporary closure of the following segments of State Right of Way for the 2011 Run for the Red;

Business 224, through downtown, along Main Street from Park Street to Washington Street, ending at Caddo Street for the purpose of Commerce Annual Bois d'Arc Bash; September 10, 2011

WHEREAS, the City Council believes temporary closure of the aforementioned streets is in the best interest of the citizens of Commerce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for the temporary street closure for a segment of the State highway system as more fully described above.

SECTION 2. That is any section, provision, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word in this Resolution or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution, and the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, hereby declares it would have enacted such remaining portions, despite such invalidity.

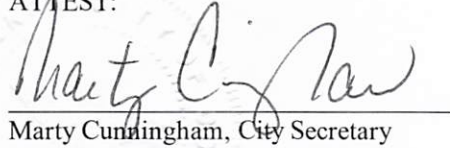
SECTION 3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately.

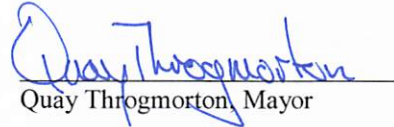

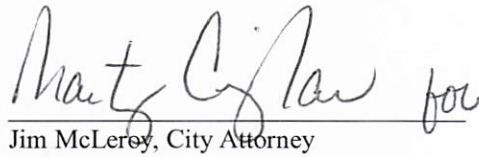

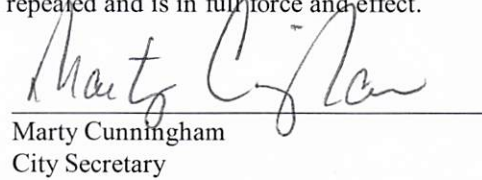
