

RESOLUTION. 11-27

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO BIDS RECEIVED FOR THE SIDEWALK PROJECT ON VACANT LOTS ACROSS STREET FROM CITY HALL; AWARDING BID TO LF MILLER CONSTRUCTION; AND ALL OTHER BIDS BEING REJECTED. GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNATURE TO ANY AND ALL INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall, on the 16th day of August 2011, at 6:00 p.m. a majority of Council Members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce, Texas, has heretofore advertised for bids for the completion of the Sidewalk Project on vacant lots across from City Hall; and

WHEREAS, two companies bid on said project, reference is hereby made to the bids contained in their bid proposals; and

WHEREAS, the bid of LF Miller Construction was the most acceptable bid for the said project, a copy of such bid tabulation being attached to said resolution and marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if copied herein verbatim; and

WHEREAS, after review of said bids contained therein the City Council deems it to be in the best interest and welfare of the City of Commerce that the bid of LF Miller Construction in the amount of \$55,887.50 be accepted and is hereby accepted, and all other bids be rejected; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, that the City of Commerce accept the bid of LF Miller Construction for the Sidewalk Project across from City Hall in the amount of \$55,887.50, all other bids hereby being rejected.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Commerce, Texas, be authorized and he is hereby authorized to execute said resolution;

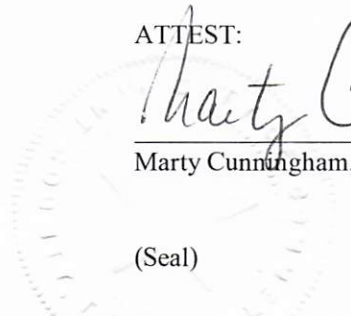
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Secretary be authorized and she is hereby authorized to attest to the signature of the Mayor to said resolution;

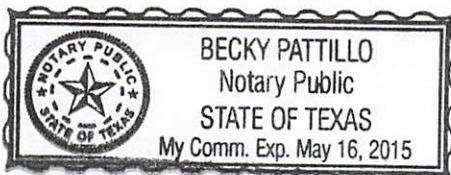
