

RESOLUTION NO. 11-34

A RESOLUTION SETTING A DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR TWO PUBLIC HEARINGS ON THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF ALLIANCE CARPET CUSHION BY THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO PUBLISH NOTICE OF SUCH PUBLIC HEARINGS AND PROVIDING THAT NOTICE CONTAIN PROVISION RESPECTING AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE PLAN; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO THIS RESOLUTION.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall on the 16th day of August, 2011 at 6:00 p.m.; a majority of Council Members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 43 of the Local Government Code, two Public Hearings will be held giving all interested persons the right to appear and be heard on the proposed annexation of Alliance Carpet Cushion by the City of Commerce, Texas.

WHEREAS, the first of such hearings to be conducted on the 20th of September 2011 at 6:00 p.m. at a Regular Meeting held by the City Council in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Commerce, Texas; such time and place being not more than forty days nor less than twenty days prior to institution of such proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the second of such hearings to be conducted on the 27th of September at 4:30 p.m. at a Special Meeting held by the Commerce City Council such place being located in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Commerce, Texas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Commerce, Texas, be authorized and he is hereby authorized to affix his signature to this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Secretary be authorized and she is hereby authorized to attest to the signature of the Mayor to this Resolution.
