

RESOLUTION NO. 11-44

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RELEASING OF LIEN OF PROPERTY GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNATURE TO THIS RESOLUTION.
