

RESOLUTION 12-20

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO BIDS RECEIVED FOR DEMOLITION OF STRUCTURES LOCATED AT 1907 PARK STREET, COMMERCE, TEXAS; AWARDING BID TO MERCURY SERVICES OF COMMERCE, TEXAS AND ALL OTHER BIDS BEING REJECTED. GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNATURE TO ANY AND ALL INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall, on the 19th day of June 2012, at 6:00 p.m.; a majority of Council Members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce, Texas, has heretofore advertised for bids for demolition of structures located at 1907 Park Street in the City of Commerce, Texas; and

WHEREAS, three bids were received for the demolition of said structures, reference is hereby made to the bid contained in the bid proposal; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Mercury Services, in the amount of \$31,617.00 for 1907 Park Street, a copy of such bid tabulation being attached to said resolution and marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if copied herein verbatim; and

WHEREAS, after review of said bid contained therein the City Council deems it to be in the best interest and welfare of the City of Commerce that the bid of Mercury Services, for the demolition of structures located at 1907 Park Street in the amount of \$31,617.00, be accepted and is hereby accepted, and all other bids be rejected;

WHEREAS, the City Manager has assured the City Council of the availability of funds for payment of the debt to be created for such purchase.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Commerce, Texas, be and he is hereby authorized to execute said resolution;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Secretary be and she is hereby authorized to attest to the signature of the Mayor to said resolution;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to execute any and all instruments requisite in implementing said resolution;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Secretary be and she is hereby authorized to attest to the signature of the City Manager to any and all instruments requisite to implementing said resolution.

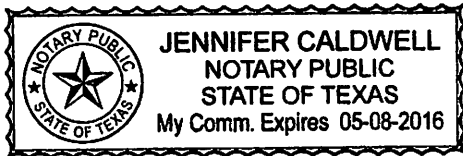
