

RESOLUTION 15-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low to moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

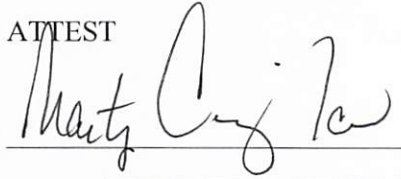
WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of Commerce to apply for funding under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

1. That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program application for the Community Development Fund is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Texas Department of Agriculture.
2. That the City's application be placed in competition for funding under the Community Development Fund.
3. That the application be for \$275,000.00 of grant funds to provide sewer system improvements.
4. That the City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program.
5. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition, and civil rights requirements.
6. That it further be stated that the City of Commerce is committing \$55,000.00 from its General Fund as a cash contribution toward the construction activities of this sewer system improvements project.
