

RESOLUTION 16 - 25

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS APPOINTING JENNIFER REEVES AS TEMPORARY MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE; SETTING FORTH OTHER PROVISIONS RELATED THERETO; PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall on the 16th day of August 2016, at 6:00 p.m.; a majority of Council Members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce, Texas, a Home Rule Municipality acting by and through its City Council, requires the appointment of a Temporary Municipal Court Judge to fill a vacancy in the position of the Regular Municipal Court Judge; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce has determined and does here now declare that the adoption of this resolution is necessary to the health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City and persons who are complainants and defendants in the Municipal Court of the City; and

WHEREAS, Jennifer Reeves has experience serving as the Justice of the Peace in Precinct 2 of Hunt County, Texas, and has offered her services free of charge to serve as Temporary Municipal Court Judge.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS THAT:

Jennifer Reeves is hereby appointed to serve as Temporary Municipal Court Judge for the City of Commerce, effective immediately, for the purposes of hearing all cases filed in the Municipal Court of the City of Commerce. This service will be free of charge to the City of Commerce and the term of said service will expire on _____, 2016.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and adoption.
