

RESOLUTION 17 - 06

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF COMMERCE, TEXAS,
OPPOSING ANY LEGISLATION REGULATING THE REVENUE STREAMS
AVAILABLE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES THAT DIRECTLY
PROVIDE SERVICES TO THEIR CITIZENS**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce is incorporated as a municipal government to directly provide services to the residents of the City of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, local government is the level of government most closely connected to our citizens and most directly engaged in services affecting the quality of life within our community;

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature is considering legislation that would place revenue caps on local governments, thereby limiting our capacity to provide consistent and improving service levels and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 2 and others like it are threats to the ability of local governments to meet the needs of the citizens we serve

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS AS FOLLOWS:

The City of Commerce is opposed to any legislation regulating the revenue streams available to local governmental entities that provide services to friends, families, and neighbors of the members of the governing body and most directly serve the needs of the taxpayers.

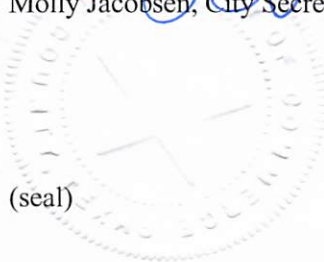

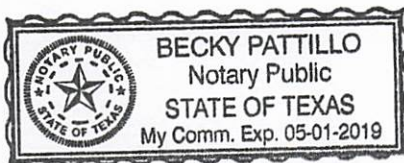
