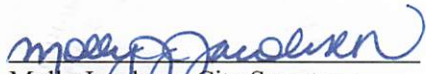
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Commerce, Texas be authorized and he is hereby authorized to affix his signature to this Resolution.

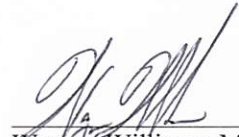
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Secretary be authorized and she is hereby authorized to attest to the signature of the Mayor to this Resolution.

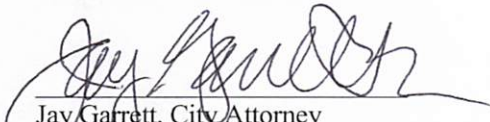

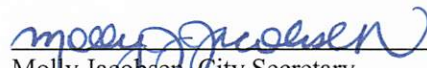

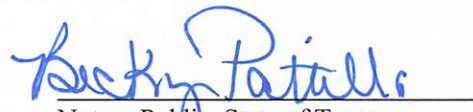
