**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
COMMERCE, TEXAS CANCELLING A FINANCIAL COMMITMENT
TO THE MAYO GRAVESITE ON THE CAMPUS OF TEXAS A&M
UNIVERSITY – COMMERCE**

WHEREAS, in October of 2015, the City of Commerce committed a total of \$50,000 in funding to the Mayo Gravesite Renovation on the campus of Texas A&M University - Commerce;

WHEREAS, the letter of intent establishing the commitment allows the commitment to be cancelled in the event of unforeseen circumstances;

WHEREAS, the leadership at the City of Commerce has experienced significant changes since the adoption of the financial commitment to the Mayo Gravesite Renovation project;

AND WHEREAS, it has become necessary to reduce expenditures in the City's General Fund budget;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
COMMERCE, TEXAS THAT THE FINANCIAL COMMITMENT TO THE MAYO
GRAVESITE RENOVATION ON THE CAMPUS OF TEXAS A&M - COMMERCE.**

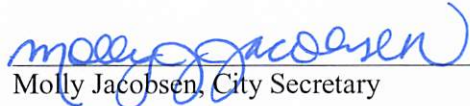
