

RESOLUTION NO. 17- 48

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A MUTUAL AID FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT WITH HOPKINS COUNTY FIRE; GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT WITH COOPER AND ALL OTHER INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNATURE TO THE AGREEMENT AND ANY INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall, on the 21st day of November, 2017, at 6:00 p.m.; a majority of council members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, Hopkins County Fire Department, desires to enter into a mutual aide agreement with the City of Commerce, and in connection therewith has submitted an agreement to said City of Commerce for its consideration, a copy of which is attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if copied herein verbatim;

AND WHEREAS, after careful deliberation by the City Council of the City of Commerce, it is deemed to be in the best interest and general welfare of the City of Commerce, that said agreement be approved;

AND WHEREAS, the agreement marked Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, between Hopkins County, and the City of Commerce for mutual aid firefighting services, be approved and accepted and is hereby approved and accepted in all respects.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the City of Commerce, Texas, be and he is hereby authorized to execute said resolution;

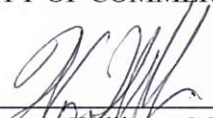
