A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY – COMMERCE FOR THE INSTALLMENT OF CITY PRIDE SIGNS ALONG STATE HIGHWAYS NEAR THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) developed the City Pride Sign Program to give cities the opportunity to display the names logos of their civic organizations along state highways without interfering with official highway signs;

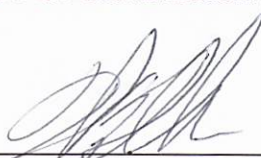
AND WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce desires to continually promote the positive and unique aspects of Commerce to residents and guests alike.

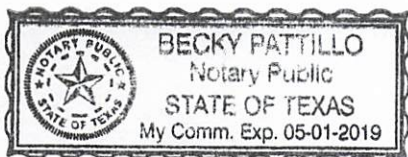
