WHEREAS, the Commerce City Council would like to continue to show appreciate to Mr. Faires for his decades of service to the community and the citizens.

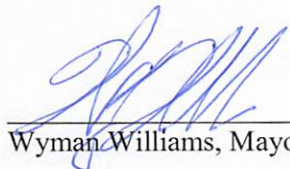
