

RESOLUTION 18 - 25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, ENCOURAGING THE STATE OF TEXAS AND APPROPRIATE FEDERAL AGENCIES TO TAKE AGGRESSIVE ACTION TO REMEDY THE NATURAL OBSTRUCTION OF THE SOUTH SULPHUR RIVER AND ALLEVIATE THE FLOODING AS WELL AS THE ENVIROMENTAL CONCERNS CAUSED BY THE ACCUMULATION OF LIMBS, LOGS, AND OTHER DEBRIS.

WHEREAS, the South Sulphur River is adjacent to the southern boundary of the City of Commerce;

WHEREAS, over time the South Sulphur River has accumulated limbs, logs, and other debris, resulting in a natural obstruction and frequent flooding; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce recognizes the concerns of our citizens regarding the natural obstruction of the South Sulphur River caused by the accumulation of limbs, logs, and other debris which has caused flooding of the surrounding area and the negative impact not only on the river flow itself but the environment of the public and private areas bordering the river;

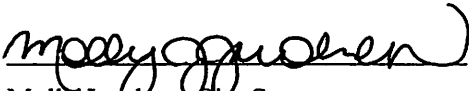
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

The State of Texas and all appropriate federal agencies are encouraged to take aggressive action to remedy the natural obstruction of the South Sulphur River and alleviate the flooding as well as the environmental concerns caused by the accumulation of limb, logs, and other debris;

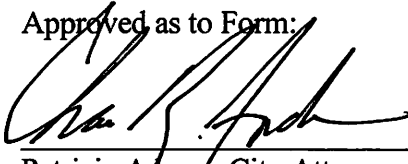

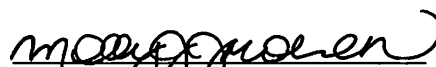

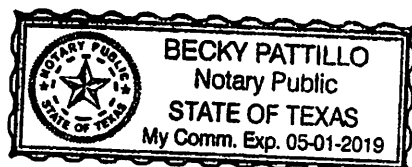
