

RESOLUTION 18 - 28

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS SUPPORTING UPPER TRINITY REGIONAL WATER DISTRICT'S PROPOSED LAKE RALPH HALL IN SOUTHEAST FANNIN COUNTY.

WHEREAS, in 1990, Commerce entered into a long-term partnership with Upper Trinity Regional Water District, a wholesale provider of treated drinking water and wastewater treatment services for cities and utilities in Denton and Collin Counties ("Upper Trinity"), whereby Upper Trinity assumed Commerce's rights and obligations under its agreement with Sulphur River Municipal Water District for water from Chapman Lake;

WHEREAS, the partnership with Upper Trinity has proven very beneficial for Commerce, and Commerce looks forward to continuing its partnership with Upper Trinity well into the future; and

WHEREAS, Upper Trinity has acquired a water rights permit from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for a new water supply lake in southeast Fannin County named Lake Ralph Hall;

WHEREAS, a permit is currently pending with the United States Army Corps of Engineers regarding the construction of the dam for the proposed Lake Ralph Hall;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce recognizes the potential benefits Lake Ralph Hall will likely bring to Commerce residents and businesses.

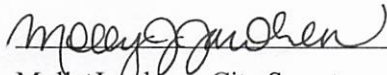
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

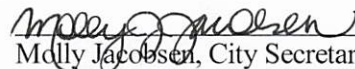

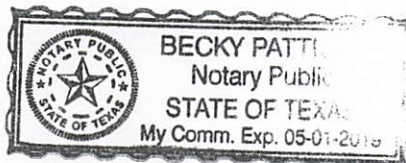
