

RESOLUTION 19 - 45

Approving the submission of a Grant Application for the Mobile Data Terminal & Hardware Grant

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Commerce, Texas, in Hunt County that the Mobile Data Terminal and Hardware Grant be operated for the year 2019-2020; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City of Commerce assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce designates Mayor Wyman Williams as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commerce City Council approves submission of the grant application for the Mobile Data Terminal and Hardware Grant to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Commerce hereby directs the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City of Commerce, at the appropriate time, and with the appropriate authorizations of this governing body, all contracts and agreements as shall be necessary and appropriate for the implementation of the grant;

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Secretary be authorized, and she is hereby authorized to attest to the signature of the City Manager to any and all instruments requisite in implementing this resolution.
