

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 04

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE REPAIR OF THE WATER FILTERS AT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the steel filters at the Commerce Water Plant are over 40 years old and have begun leaking;

WHEREAS, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has asked that the filters be repaired by April of 2020; and

WHEREAS, Hayter Engineering engineered a solution and issued a request for proposals which was posted and competitively bid in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws; and

WHEREAS, on January 15, the City received two responsive bids for the project; and

WHEREAS, BCAC Underground LLC provided with their bid a factory certification for the product specified in the plans to be utilized to complete the water filter repair project;

AND WHEREAS, Hayter Engineering recommends award of contract to the lowest bidder, BCAC Underground, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS THAT THE CONTRACT FOR THE REPAIR OF THE WATER FILTERS AT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT BE AWARDED TO BCAC UNDERGROUND, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$63,500; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE CITY MANAGER IS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE MOTOR CONTROL CENTER REPLACEMENT AT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT

AND IT IS SO RESOLVED.

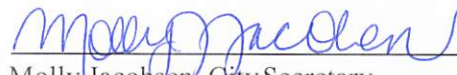

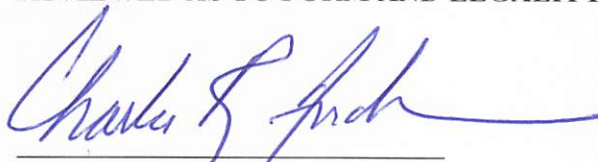
