

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 06

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NO. ONE (1) FOR THE CENTENNIAL PARK GRANT PROJECT WITH TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, in 2016, the City was awarded a Texas Parks & Wildlife Parks grant for the Extension of Centennial Park to include walking trails, a 9-hole disc golf course and a skate park; and

WHEREAS, Commerce Independent School District (CISD) donated 8.71 acres east of AC Williams to the City of Commerce and transferred that land to the City as a contribution to the expansion of Centennial Park; and

WHEREAS, Texas Parks & Wildlife awarded the City \$150,000 with a 50/50 match in 2016, of which a portion of the City's match was met through the donation of land from the school district; and

WHEREAS, this Centennial Park disc-golf and skate park project was constructed by Hayter Engineering and funded through July of 2020; and

WHEREAS, in October of 2018, the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas approved the bid from M-Pak Construction and entered into a contract for the construction of the disc-golf course and skate park at Centennial Park; and

WHEREAS, all construction of the park, with the exception of the walking trail, has been completed and upon a review of expenditures and a site visit by Texas Parks & Wildlife; it was confirmed the City has satisfied our match requirement; and

WHEREAS, Change Order No. 1 will remove the walking trail from being required to complete the project and proceed with closing the grant; and

WHEREAS, the City will complete the walking trail with materials from Hunt County and utilizing internal resources and staff apart from the Texas Parks & Wildlife Grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

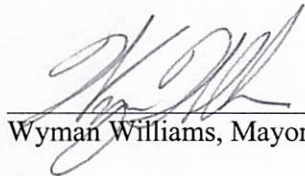

AND IT IS SO RESOLVED.

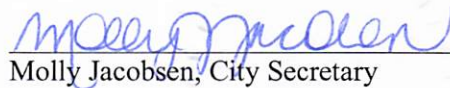

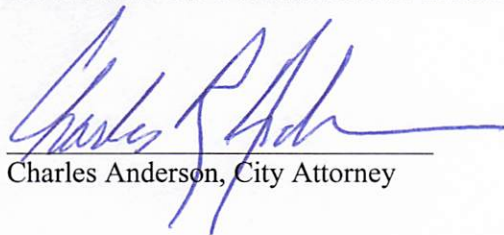
