

RESOLUTION 20 - 43

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER HOWDY LISENBEE AS A SIGNER FOR CASH MANAGEMENT SYSTEM ONLINE BANKING FOR CITY OF COMMERCE ALLIANCE BANK ACCOUNTS; AND GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING THIS RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNATURE TO THIS RESOLUTION.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall, on the 20th day of October 2020, at 6:00 p.m., a majority of council members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, accounts have been established in the name of the City of Commerce with Alliance Bank wherein may be deposited any of the funds of the City of Commerce whether by cash, checks, note, or other evidences of debt, and from which withdrawals may be made in the name of the City of Commerce by duly authorized individuals of the City of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, the Article 5, Section 37 of the City of Commerce Code of Ordinances Charter designates all financial transactions be signed by the City Manager and countersigned by the City Secretary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce has deemed it necessary to remove Ned Muse, Interim City Manager from the list of authorized signers and add Interim City Manager Howdy Lisenbee as a signer on City Alliance Bank Accounts.

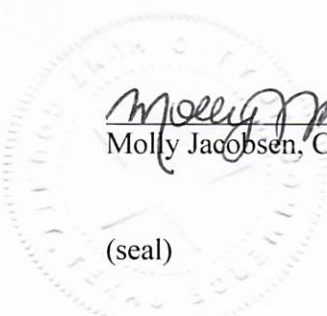
