**RESOLUTION DEDICATING EXISTING PARK LAND TO BE USED FOR THE
CREATION OF THE COMMERCE DOG PARK AND ALLOCATED BUDGETED FUNDS
TO BUILD THE FENCES NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH THE DOG PARK BOUNDARIES**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce, Texas (the City) is a duly created home-rule governmental body of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City provides a network of Parks & Recreation facilities to promote the health and wellbeing of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Commerce Parks Advisory Board (the Board) has presented their recommendations for the location and creation of the Commerce Dog Park on existing City owned Park land.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE THAT:

Section 1. The City Council supports the creation of a Commerce Dog Park, and dedicates land generally located within the Northwest corner of City Park, to be used as the location of the Commerce Dog Park.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes staff to reallocate previously budgeted capital project funds within the FY21 Budget in the amount of \$16,542 to be used for fencing and miscellaneous site improvements in support of the Commerce Dog Park.

Section 3. The City Council authorizes The Friends of the Commerce Dog Park to raise funds and work with City staff to expend those funds for the benefit of the Commerce Dog Park.

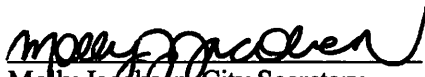
