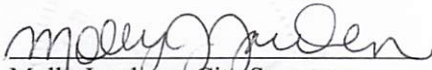
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Commerce, Texas be authorized and he is hereby authorized to affix his signature to this Resolution.

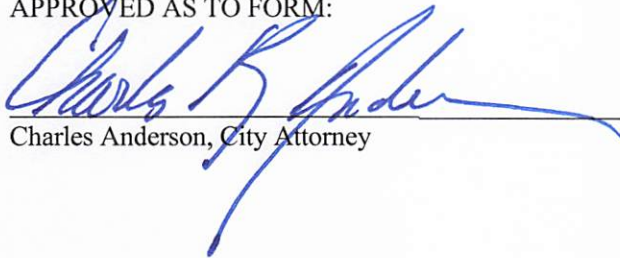
