

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 09

A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING CITY OF COMMERCE HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX GRANTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022. AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO SAID RESOLUTION. AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL OTHER INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE TO IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNATURE TO ANY AND ALL OTHER INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE TO IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, was held in Commerce, Texas, at City Hall on the 15th day of June 2021, at 6:00 p.m.; a majority of Council Members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted;

WHEREAS, the current fund balance for the Hotel Occupancy Tax (HOT) fund is about \$20,700 and the budgeted revenue for collections in Fiscal Year 2022 is \$20,000; and

WHEREAS, the City expects to end Fiscal Year 2021 with a fund balance of \$25,975 in the Hotel Occupancy Tax (HOT) fund which can be allocated in part or completely, as deemed by the City Council of the City of Commerce.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce deems it to be in the best interest and general welfare of the City of Commerce that said allocations be granted to qualifying applicants for the Hotel Occupancy Tax (HOT) funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Commerce grants allocation to the following groups for the following amounts:

Commerce, Texas Chamber of Commerce	\$3,000
Northeast Texas Children's Museum	\$3,750
Texas A&M University-Commerce	\$12,000
Louise Drake Garden Club of Commerce	\$800

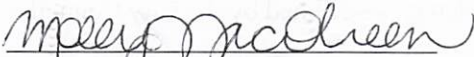
