RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 10

A RESOLUTION OF THE **CITY OF COMMERCE** ADOPTING THE 2021 HUNT COUNTY
HAZARD MITIGATION ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, the **CITY OF COMMERCE** recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Hunt County; and

WHEREAS, Hunt County has prepared a multi-jurisdictional, multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the 2021 Hunt County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan (HazMAP) in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the 2021 Hunt County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the **CITY OF COMMERCE** from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, the plan is not legally binding and mitigation actions identified can be implemented as funding and capabilities allow; and

WHEREAS, adoption by **CITY OF COMMERCE** demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2021 Hunt County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE **COMMERCE, TEXAS**, THAT:

Section 1. In accordance with **Part I, Article 3, Section 26 of the Charter for the City of Commerce**, the **City Council of the CITY OF COMMERCE** adopts this Resolution and thereby adopts the 2021 Hunt County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan.
