A RESOLUTION RELATING TO PROPOSALS RECEIVED FOR AN EMPLOYEE INSURANCE AND BENEFITS BROKER FOR THE CITY OF COMMERCE, AWARDED THE BID TO JBA FINANCIAL SERVICES; ALL OTHER PROPOSALS BEING REJECTED. GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID RESOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE MAYOR'S SIGNATURE TO SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING SAID RESOLUTION, AND AUTHORIZING CITY SECRETARY TO AUTHENTICATE CITY MANAGER'S SIGNATURE TO ANY INSTRUMENTS REQUISITE IN IMPLEMENTING THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, after review of said proposals contained therein, the City Council deems that the proposal for an Insurance Broker for City of Commerce employees be accepted and is hereby accepted, and all other proposals rejected; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the bid of JBA Financial Services is hereby accepted according to the terms of the bid

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Commerce, Texas, be authorized and he is hereby authorized to execute this resolution;

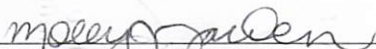
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Secretary be authorized and she is hereby authorized to attest to the signature of the Mayor to this resolution;
