

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 47

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
COMMERCE, TEXAS AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE DESIGN
OF STREET AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY
DOCUMENTATION.**

WHEREAS, the pumps at the Commerce Wastewater Treatment Plant are in a state of significant disrepair to the extent that 1 of the 3 existing pumps are operable;

WHEREAS, the City Council has indicated that infrastructure improvements in the City's utilities is a primary concern for them in Fiscal Year 2022; and

WHEREAS, Hayter Engineering engineered a solution and issued a request for proposals which was posted and competitively bid in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, the City received four responsive bids for the project; and

WHEREAS, the bid from Fryer Construction appears to conform with all contract documents and based upon a formal review of the Statement of Bidder's Qualifications and reference checks, the Engineer deems Fryer Construction to be responsive and capable of providing the services necessary to complete the pump replacement project;

AND WHEREAS, Hayter Engineering recommends award of contract to the lowest bidder, Fryer Construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS THAT THE CONTRACT FOR THE REPAIR OF THE PUMPS AT THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT BE AWARDED TO FRYER CONSTRUCTION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$309,900.00; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE CITY MANAGER IS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE PUMP REPLACEMENT PROJECT AT THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

AND IT IS SO RESOLVED.

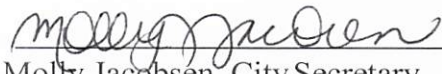
