

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 48

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
COMMERCE, TEXAS AWARDED A CONTRACT FOR THE DESIGN
OF STREET AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY
DOCUMENTATION.**

WHEREAS, in 2020, the City of Commerce completed a street study through Applied Research Associates, Inc., formerly Dynatest, and purchased Paver software to establish and maintain pavement condition index scores for all streets within Commerce city limits; and

WHEREAS, the Commerce City Council has indicated that an infrastructure improvement plan is a priority for them in Fiscal Year 2022; and

WHEREAS, The Council has previously identified their initial priority street projects for the FY 2022 Budget to be:

- Monroe Street from Live Oak to Walnut;
- Park Street from Maple to Culver,
- Hickory Street (from Chestnut to Maple)
- Washington Street (from Live Oak to Culver); and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement from Freese & Nichols will meet or exceed the City's needs for Design Services and Construction Administration to carry out this project;

AND WHEREAS, City Staff recommends award of contract for design services related to the FY 2022 Street & Drainage Improvements to Freese & Nichols.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS THAT THE CONTRACT FOR THE STREETS & DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT BE AWARDED TO FREESE & NICHOLS (FNI) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$218,613.00; AND

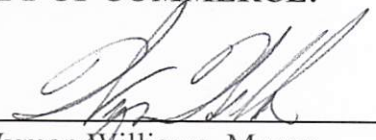
