

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 09

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
COMMERCE, TEXAS AWARDED A CONTRACT FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF AN INCLUSIVE PLAYGROUND AT IVORY
MOORE AND CITY PARK AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO SIGN AND EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY
DOCUMENTATION.**

WHEREAS, the playground equipment at both City Park and Ivory Moore Park within Commerce are very outdated and nearing a point of hazard for safe recreation as they have reached a state of significant disrepair;

WHEREAS, the City Council identified improvements at these Parks as priority projects in their Fiscal Year 2022 Capital Improvement Plans, as outlined in Ordinance 2021-27 which adopted the City's FY 2022 CIP Plan; and

WHEREAS, Ivory Moore Park is scheduled to have a full playground installation as well as an outdoor fitness center; and

WHEREAS, City Park is scheduled to have an inclusive playground installation that is available to special needs and special mobility children.

WHEREAS, Staff has identified Heartland Park & Recreation as a vendor through a State purchasing contract, with competitive government pricing for the design and installation of these recreation features; and

WHEREAS, the bid from Heartland Parks & Recreation appears to conform with all contract documents and based upon a formal review of the Statement of Bidder's Qualifications and reference checks, the City deems Heartland Parks & Recreation to be responsive and capable of providing the services necessary to complete the park improvement project;

AND WHEREAS, the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board recommended the award of contract to Heartland unanimously at their January board meeting.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF COMMERCE, TEXAS THAT THE CONTRACT FOR THE INCLUSIVE
PLAYGROUND AT IVORY MOORE PARK BE AWARDED TO HEARTLAND IN
AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$508,708.80; AND**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE CITY MANAGER IS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE AFOREMENTIONED PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AT IVORY MOORE AND CITY PARK.

AND IT IS SO RESOLVED.

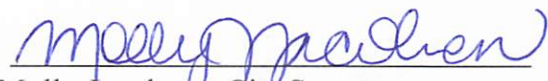
