

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 10

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
COMMERCE, TEXAS AWARDED A CONTRACT FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF A SPLASH PAD AT CITY PARK AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AND EXECUTE
ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION.**

WHEREAS, within the FY22 Capital Improvements Plan, the City Council authorized the development of a new Splashpad Water Recreation Project for FY 2022; and

WHEREAS, Staff is using a Design-Build project delivery method, in accordance with all applicable local and state Laws.; and

WHEREAS, over the past two months, staff has worked with a selection committee of both staff and Advisory Board members to request proposals for the design and construction of this project and after several meetings and numerous deliberations, the committee has recommended that Heartland Park & Recreation be selected as the Best Value proposal for the Splashpad Project..

WHEREAS, the bid from Heartland Parks & Recreation appears to conform with all contract documents and based upon a formal review of the Statement of Bidder's Qualifications and reference checks, the City deems Heartland Parks & Recreation to be responsive and capable of providing the services necessary to complete the park improvement project;

AND WHEREAS, the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board recommended the award of contract to Heartland unanimously at their January board meeting.

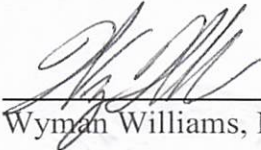
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS THAT THE CONTRACT FOR THE SPLASH PAD AT CITY PARK BE AWARDED TO HEARTLAND IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$940,000.00; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE CITY MANAGER IS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE AFOREMENTIONED SPLASH PAD PROJECT AT CITY PARK.

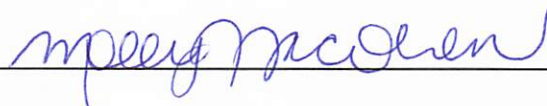
