

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 – 16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 300 KVA DIESEL FUELED, PORTABLE GENERATOR FOR THE COMMERCE RAW WATER PUMP STATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$174,202.00, FROM CLIFFORD POWER; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Commerce to purchase one (1) 300 KVA, diesel fueled, portable generator, for the City of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2021- 2022 (“FY 2022”) budget included funding leftover from the Wastewater Plant pump replacement project; and

WHEREAS, this portable 300 KVA generator will allow the City the flexibility to provide power to the primary pump at the raw water pump station and also provide back-up power options at other locations in the City; and

WHEREAS, this piece of equipment will be purchased through a Buy Board State Purchasing Contract for \$174,202.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of one (1) portable generator from Clifford Power in the amount of \$174, 202.00; as described in Exhibit “A” attached hereto; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Commerce, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of said purchase of one (1) portable generator, shall be funded from the Public Utilities Fund in the amount of approximately \$174, 202.00 budgeted therefor.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and it is so resolved.
