

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 24

A RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 7, 2022 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING CITY COUNCIL MAYOR , FOR A TERM OF THREE (3) YEARS; AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING CITY COUNCIL MEMBER PLACE FOUR (4), FOR AN UNEXPIRED TERM OF TWO (2) YEARS; PROVIDING FOR THE INCORPORATION OF PREMISES; PROVIDING FOR CONFIRMATION OF VOTE TABULATIONS AND DECLARING THE MEMBERS ELECTED; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR CANVASS OF GENERAL AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION; DECLARING OPEN MEETING COMPLIANCE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. CONFIRMING ELECTION BY UNOPPOSED CANDIDACY FOR BOTH MAYOR AND PLACE FOUR; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A CANVASS OF A GENERAL ELECTION; ISSUING CERTIFICATES OF ELECTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there came to be considered the returns of both a General & a Special Election held on the 7th day of May, 2022 for the purpose of electing the hereinafter named official(s), and it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made,

WHEREAS, the returns of the General & Special Municipal Election, including the returns of early ballots cast in connection therewith, duly and legally made, showed that there were cast at such General & Special Municipal Election, the following total valid and legal votes for each candidate as indicated below:

FOR CITY COUNCIL, MAYOR:

Teddy Reel

Unopposed Candidate declared Elected

FOR CITY COUNCIL, PLACE FOUR (4):

Jim Ayres

Unopposed Candidate declared Elected

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS;

Section 1. Incorporation of Premises. The above and foregoing premises are true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Resolution and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Section 2. Confirmation of Vote Tabulations. The May 7, 2022 Election was duly called; that notice of election was given in accordance with the law, and that **Mayor Teddy Reel** and **Council Member Jim Ayres** are duly elected to the Commerce City Council. The results of the General & Special Municipal Election, as canvassed and tabulated by above reflect the expressed desires of the resident qualified voters of the City and the above-named parties are hereby declared duly elected to said respective offices, subject to taking their oaths of office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas and the Charter of the City of Commerce, Texas.

Section 3. Issuance of Certificates of Election. That the current Mayor Wyman Williams is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver Certificates of Election to the successful candidates elected at the General & Special May 7, 2022 Municipal Election.

Section 4. Issuance of Canvass of General Municipal Election. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Canvass of the General Municipal Election, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, in accordance with the election laws of the State of Texas, and to take all other action necessary connection therewith.

Section 5. Open Meeting. It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of this governing body that the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located outside the City Hall, a place convenient to the public, and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the date of this meeting. A copy of the return of said posting shall be attached to the minutes of this meeting and shall be made a part thereof for all intents and purposes.

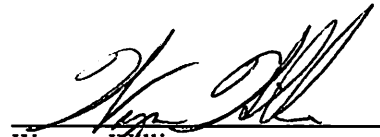
Section 6. Declaring an Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so resolved.

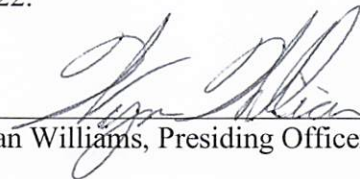


**CANVASS OF CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS
