**RESOLUTION OF ACCEPTANCE
CITY OF COMMERCE**

WHEREAS, the pumps at the Commerce Wastewater Treatment Plant were previously in a state of significant disrepair to the extent that 1 of the 3 existing pumps are operable;

WHEREAS, the City Council has indicated that infrastructure improvements in the City's utilities was a primary concern for them in Fiscal Year 2022; and

WHEREAS, Hayter Engineering engineered a solution and issued a request for proposals which was posted and competitively bid in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws in September and October 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce entered into contract with Fryer Construction Company, for the construction of the WWTP Master Lift Station Pump Replacement project, TWDB CWSRF # 72263;

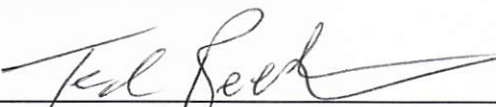

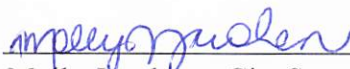
BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Commerce that the project is accepted as constructed.

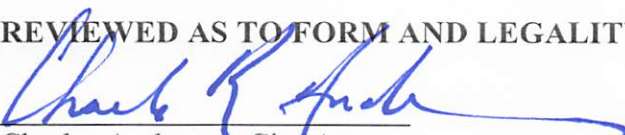
