

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 – 38

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) SUTPHEN MONARCH FIRE ENGINE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$820,000.00 FROM SUTPHEN CORPORATION FOR USE BY COMMERCE FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the Commerce Fire Department currently has an engine that is 21-years old and whose maintenance costs exceed a reasonable cost to maintain fire apparatus and the engine has become largely unreliable; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Commerce to purchase one (1) fire engine, for use within Hunt County and the City of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, due to supply chain issues, the current build lead time is approximately 26 months and we face a price increase of approximately \$40,000 if we don't commit to this purchase to begin the process of building the engine; and

WHEREAS, the purchase from Sutphen Corporation through the Texas Buy Board Program has been determined to be the best and most responsible method of purchasing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, hereby approves the purchase of one (1) Sutphen Monarch Fire Engine from Sutphen Corporation in the amount of \$820,000; as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and further authorizes the City Manager to execute all purchase documents relating thereto on behalf of the City of Commerce, Texas.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and it is so resolved.
