

RESOLUTION 2023 – 02 - 02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE
APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
STATE RIGHT OF WAY ON MARCH 25, 2023 FOR RALLY ROUND EMMA
EVENT; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas was held in Commerce, Texas at City Hall, on the 21st day of February, 2023 at 6:00 p.m., a majority of council members being present and constituting a quorum, the following resolution was adopted.

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to assist in sharing resources and facilities for the purpose of hosting an event called “Rally Round Emma”; and

WHEREAS, City Staff requests approval of the temporary closure of the following segments of State Right of Way for the March 25, 2023 Event as follows:

Business 224, through downtown, along Main Street from Park Street to Washington, ending at Caddo Street for the purpose of a fundraising event for “Emma’s Day”.

WHEREAS, the agreement is valid for the event on the day of March 25, 2023 only.

WHEREAS, the City Council believes temporary closure of the aforementioned streets is in the best interest of the citizens of Commerce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The city Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for the temporary street closure for a segment of the State Highway system as more fully described above.

SECTION 2. That is any section, provision, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word in this Resolution thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution, and the City Council of the City of Commerce, hereby declares it would have enacted such remaining portions, despite such invalidity.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately.

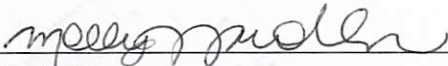

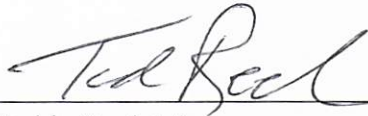
