

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 – 10 – 05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, APPROVING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH MX CONSTRUCTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,411,400.35 FOR THE COMMERCE FY 2022 STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; ALLOCATING FUNDING FROM THE CITY'S 2021, 2022 AND 2023 ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce released a request for proposals for the construction of the city's 2022 street and drainage improvement project and received three bids which were opened on September 20, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has identified street and drainage improvement projects which are a priority based on pavement index scores and traffic counts associated with some of the most utilized and traversed streets in Commerce; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work for this project will include the full reconstruction of Washington Street (from Live Oak to Culver) to include underground utilities; the full reconstruction of Park Street (from Maple to Culver); and the full reconstruction of Hickory Street (from Chestnut to Maple); and

WHEREAS, city staff recommends award of contract to bidder, MX Construction Services, Inc. out of Ft. Worth, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, hereby approves the Construction Contract with MX Construction Services, Inc. in the amount of \$4,411,400.35 for the cost of labor, equipment, and materials to construct the street and drainage improvements for the City of Commerce 2022 Street & Drainage Improvements which will include the following: (1) reconstruction of Washington Street from Live Oak to Culver, (2) the reconstruction of Park Street from Maple to Culver and (3) the full reconstruction of Hickory Street (from Chestnut to Maple).

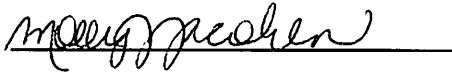
Section 3: The City Council authorizes the use of funding in the amount of \$1.5 million from the city's 2021 issuance of Certificates of Obligation (CO), in the amount of \$1.495 million from the city's 2022 issuance of COs & in the amount of \$1,416,400.35 from the 2023 issuance of COs to fund this project.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and it is so resolved.

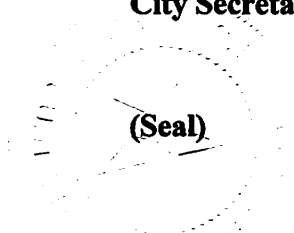
