

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 – 11 - 04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS, ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE TEXAS FOREST SERVICE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$240,000; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL PURCHASE DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Commerce to budget for the purchase of one (1) brush truck, for the City of Commerce Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2023- 2024 (“FY 2024”) budget includes funding for the purchase of a piece of large equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently in possession of a 2002 brush truck that has high mileage and high maintenance costs associated with keeping it operational for the needs of the department and the community; and

WHEREAS, Texas A&M Forest Service provides funding assistance via grants to fire departments for the acquisition of brush trucks and is a cost-share program funded by the Texas Legislature; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT, the above findings are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2: THAT, the City Council of the City of Commerce, Texas, hereby approves the acceptance of a grant from the Texas A&M Forest Service for assistance in funding of a new firefighting vehicle; and further authorizes the City Manager or his designee to execute all necessary documentation relating thereto on behalf of the City of Commerce, Texas.

Section 3: THAT, the cost of one (1) Skeeter CV-515 Brush Truck, shall be funded from the Equipment Replacement Fund and this grant, if accepted, in the amount of approximately \$350,000.

Section 4: THAT, This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and it is so resolved.

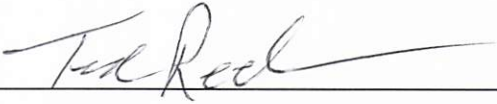
