

RESOLUTION 2024 – 04 - 03

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS
AWARDING A CONTRACT TO SUPERIOR EQUIPMENT SOLUTIONS, LLC FOR
THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BISHOP STREET LIFT STATION AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AND EXECUTE ANY
NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION.**

WHEREAS, the City Council identified infrastructure improvements as priority projects in their Fiscal Year 2023 and Fiscal Year 2024 Capital Improvement Plans, as outlined in Ordinance 2022-18 which adopted the City's FY 2023 CIP Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City's sewer collection system utilizes a series of lift stations to move sewage waste through the city and to the Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP); and

WHEREAS, Each lift station includes a high volume collection chamber into which the sewage drains and at the bottom of the chamber is a grinder pump which renders the flow to as much liquid as possible; and

WHEREAS, Staff has identified the pump station on Highway 71 at Bishop Street has reached a point of failure and is no longer consistently reliable in our wastewater treatment process; and

WHEREAS, the bid from Superior Equipment Solutions, LLC out of Mt Vernon, Texas appears to conform with all contract documents and based upon a formal review of the Statement of Bidder's Qualifications and reference checks, the City deems Superior Equipment Solutions, LLC to be responsive and capable of providing the services necessary to complete the Bishop Street Lift Station project;

AND WHEREAS, city staff recommends the award of contract to Superior Equipment Solutions, LLC in the amount of \$232,673.67.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, TEXAS THAT THE CONTRACT FOR THE BISHOP STREET LIFT STATION BE AWARDED TO SUPERIOR EQUIPMENT SOLUTIONS, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$232,673.67.00; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE CITY MANAGER IS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE AFOREMENTIONED BISHOP STREET LIFT STATION PROJECT.

AND IT IS SO RESOLVED.

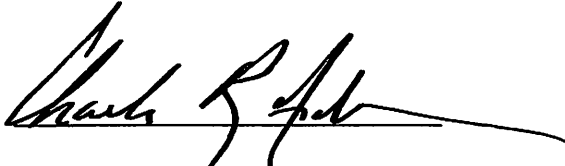

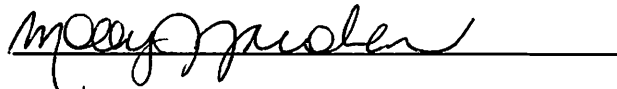
